Viral hepatitis and treatment can affect your career, education, relationships and in some cases, ability to care for yourself. Centrelink social workers are able to work with individuals, families and communities to assist in finding solutions during times of major change, such as during loss of income. They can offer short-term counselling and support and give you information on other services in the community such as health, legal services, housing assistance and support groups.

Job Services Australia is a national network of organisations dedicated to helping people find and sustain employment. It works with organisations such as the Disability Employment Service, which offers specialised employment help for people with a disability, injury or illness ...
