No, there is no cure for hepatitis B, but you can live a long, healthy life with six-monthly check-ups.

You can protect yourself from hepatitis B with vaccination.

Blood-to-blood contact, sexual fluids, and during birth when the mother has hepatitis B

**D** Is there a vaccine for hepatitis C?

No, there is no vaccine for hepatitis C.

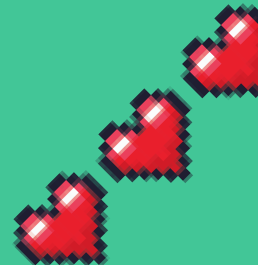
However, hepatitis C can be cured in most people with daily tablets for 8 to 12 weeks.

Most people don't experience symptoms until years later when the liver is badly damaged.

**F** Does hepatitis B or C have symptoms?

Blood-to-blood contact. For example, sharing injecting equipment, unsterile tattoos or body piercings, overseas medical or dental procedures.

**G** Can you spread hepatitis B or C from sharing cutlery, plates or cups?

No. Hepatitis B and C can not spread through sharing utensils or food.

# HEP CAN'T WAIT CHATTERBOX

**1** Cut along dotted lines

**2** Turn over - blank side up

**3** Crease in half, open back up

**4** Fold corners to centre

**5** Turn over

**6** Fold corners to centre

**7** This smaller square should look like this

**8** Fold in half

**9** To look like this

**10** Slide fingers under flaps

## HOW TO PLAY

1. Ask someone to pick a colour.
2. Move the flaps in and out as you spell out the colour. Eg. O-R-A-N-G-E (move 6 times).
3. Open the chatterbox to reveal four questions. Ask them to pick a letter. Read out the question.
4. Let them guess the answer before lifting the flap to reveal the answer.
